





2022 Australian Christian Book of the Year Award

The Australian Christian Book of the Year Award is given annually to an original book written by an Australian citizen. The award recognises and encourages excellence in Australian Christian writing.

The award carries a prize of \$3,000 for the author, and a

framed certificate for the author and publisher.

Entries are judged with an eye to the:

Original nature of the work.

Literary style, including suitability for the target audience.

Design, layout, cover, typography and illustrations.

Contribution that the book makes in meeting a need for Christian writing in the Australian situation and in the Australian market.

Entries are read and judged by a panel selected by the SparkLit Council. If, in the opinion of the judges, no entry meets the standards expected, no award will be made. A short list will be announced in early July 2022. The Australian Christian Book of the Year will be announced during the SparkLit Awards Night in Melbourne in early September 2022. All entrants and interested persons are encouraged to attend the awards event.
