



SPARKLIT AUSTRALIAN CHRISTIAN LITERATURE AWARDS CALL FOR ENTRIES

2027 Australian Christian Book of the Year Award

The Australian Christian Book of the Year Award is conferred annually for an original book written by an Australian citizen. The award recognises and encourages excellence in Australian Christian writing.

The award carries a prize of **\$3,000** for the author, and a framed certificate for the author and publisher.

Entries are judged with an eye to the:

Original nature of the work.

Literary style, including suitability for the target audience.

Design, layout, cover, typography and illustrations.

Contribution that the book makes in meeting a need for Christian writing in the Australian situation and in the Australian market.

Entries are read and judged by a panel selected by the SparkLit board. If, in the opinion of the judges, no entry meets the standards expected, no award will be made. The shortlist will be released on 1 July 2027. The 2027 Australian Christian Book of the Year will be announced during the SparkLit Awards Night in Melbourne on Thursday 19 August 2027. All entrants and interested persons are encouraged to attend the awards event.

Submission of entries

Entries must be submitted by **31 March 2027**.

Four copies of each title submitted and a **\$50** entry fee per title are required. There is no limit to the number of titles a publisher or author may submit. A new entry form is to be completed for each title. Books submitted for the award will not be returned.

A high-resolution image of the **book cover** (minimum 1350 pixels high) and photo of the **author** (landscape orientation, minimum 2000 pixels wide) must be supplied.

Shortlisted titles

We will contact the author and publisher of shortlisted books on 1 July. If a book is shortlisted its publisher will supply SparkLit with ten additional copies. Shortlisted authors agree to attend the awards event in Melbourne on Thursday 19 August 2027. If an author's availability is in doubt, SparkLit must be informed immediately.
